The power generated by Tenaska Virginia Generating Station is sold into the Pennsylvania – New Jersey – Maryland (PJM) Interconnection regional transmission organization (RTO) through a contract with Shell Energy North America. The PJM Interconnection market assures the electric reliability of the largest centrally dispatched grid in North America.
