Power generated by Tenaska Westmoreland Generating Station is sold into the PJM Interconnection (PJM) regional transmission organization to meet growing regional energy needs. PJM coordinates the flow of electricity from power generators to local utilities across the largest centrally dispatched grid in North America, which includes Pennsylvania.
