

At a glance

The power generated by the six plants that make up Tenaska River Valley Generation is sold into the PJM Interconnection (PJM) regional transmission organization (RTO) to meet growing regional energy needs. PJM coordinates the flow of electricity from power generators to local utilities in the largest centrally dispatched grid in North America, which includes Pennsylvania.






